The PMP exam is 4 hours long and consists of 200 multiple choice questions. 175 questions are scored and 25 questions are considered as pretest and not scored.

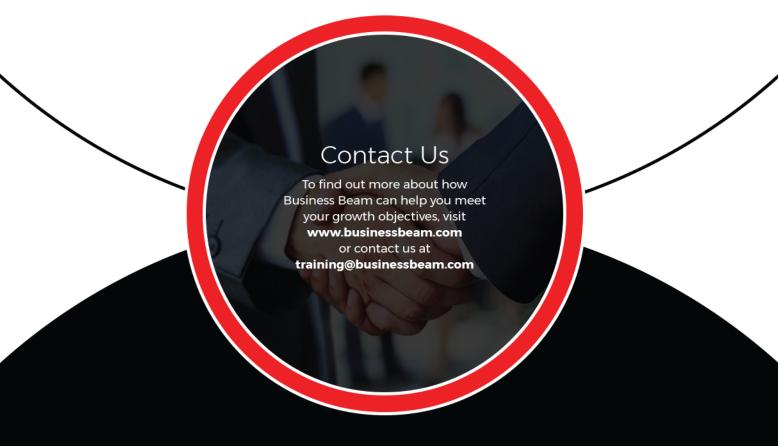
