Practice Exam

Two practice exams are part of the course. The practice exams aim to help participants in passing the PRINCE2 Practitioner certification exam.

Certification Exams

A 2.5 hour certification exam is scheduled on the last day of the course, consisting of 8 objective questions carry 10 marks each. Candidates must achieve 55% marks (44 out of 80) to receive their examination certificate. This is an open book exam (official PRINCE2 manual only).

Eligibility for Examination

To sit in the PRINCE2 Practitioner examination, candidate must provide proof of having passed one of the following:

- PRINCE2 Foundation,
- Project Management Professional (PMP),
- Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM),
- IPMA Level A® (Certified Projects Director),
- IPMA Level B® (Certified Senior Project Manager),
- IPMA Level C® (Certified Project Manager),
- IPMA Level D® (Certified Project Management Associate).
